## **Voice of GOD**



This is the 154th Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and 37th Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri in Chozha Nadu. This place was once called Thiruthuruthi (a protruding land between two rivers – like Thittai) and is now called Kuttalam. This is one of the Nalvar Paadal Petra Shiva temples, ie Thirugnanasambandar, Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal, Sundarar, and Manickavasagar have sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple.

In Periyapuranam, Sekkizhar records that Thirugnanasambandar came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Therazhundur (Mada Koil ..?).

Thirugnanasambandar, Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal, Sundarar, Manickavasagar, Ayyadigal kadavarkon and Vallalar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple. Thirugnanasambandar and Sundarar have sung hymns combining both Thiruthuruthi and Thiruvelvikudi. In that, they mention Lord Shiva with Uma will be at Thiruthuruthi during the daytime and during the night at Thiruvelvikudi. Sundarar in his hymns, requests Lord Shiva to relieve him from a decease. Later Sundarar took a dip in the temple tank and got relieved from the disease, as instructed by Lord Shiva.

Moolavar : Sri Ukthavedeeswarar, Sri Sonnavaaru Arivar. Consort : Sri Amirthamukizhambigai, Sri Arumbannavanamulayal, Sri

Imruthamukulakujambigai. Some of the important features of this temple are...... The temple faces east with a 5-tier Rajagopuram. Balipeedam,

Dwajasthambam, and Rishabam are near the sthala vruksham (Ukthala maram). In Koshtam Vinayagar, Dakshinamurthy, Lingothbavar with Brahma and Maha Vishnu on both sides, Agasthiyar, Pichadanar, Brahma, and Durgai.

In praharam Thunaivantha Vinayagar, Arumugar sitting on his Vahana Peacock with his consorts Sri Valli Devasena, Valanchuzhi Vinayagar, Murugan, Natarajar, Viswanathar, Saptarishis, 63var, Nalvars (In that Sundarar is with Paravai Nachiyar), Pancha Lingas, Navagrahas, Mangala Saneeswaran, Bhairavar, Maha Lakshmi (stucco) and Suriyan. Succo Images of Lord Shiva & Parvati's marriage is on the back side of the sanctum Sanctorum. The 15th Century Saint Arunagirinathar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Murugan of this temple. ARCHITECTURE

Ambal is in a separate temple with a separate 3-tier Rajagopuram. The sanctum Sanctorum is with sanctum, antarala, artha mandapam and mukha mandapam.

### HISTORY & INSCRIPTIONS

Since Nalvar has Sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, the original temple existed before the 7th Century. Later the same was reconstructed with stone during the Chozha period and expanded during the Pandyas and Vijayanagara periods.

As per the inscriptions this place was mentioned as "Veenguneerthuruthi" and Kalyanalaya and Lord Shiva was called Veenguneer Thiruthuruththiyudaya Mahadevar, Udayar Sonnavararivar, ThirukaRRali Mahadevar. The Chozhas and Vijayanagarathar's period inscriptions record the lands gifted as Irayili and purchase of lands, and gave permission to collect the taxes, etc. Rajendra Chozha-I's, 5th reign inscription records the endowment of feeding of Shiva devotees, to get victory in the war for which money was gifted to this temple Thiruvazhunthur Nattu Veenguneer Thiruthuruthi Sonnavararivar temple. The same King's 15th reign year inscription records a land was sold to construct a Thirumadam.



"When these houses are located in low-lying areas, the EB officials tend to suspend the power supply for the whole area even for a short spell of rains," he says, adding that the EB department should take steps to replace the domestic EB boxes to a height that would ensure it would not be affected during rains.

### Nepalese arrested for burglary

The Mambalam police have arrested four Nepalese for allegedly burgling an house in T. Nagar. According to the police Mohan Kumar and architect when he was away and returned home in South Boag Road, he found his house was broken and 20 sovereigns of gold jewellery and silver articles had been stolen.

The police identified the suspects and arrested Prakash Singh, and his associates through CCTV camera. The police said Prakash worked at an ice factory being run by Mr. Kumar's father. He had been regularly monitoring the house, and committed the burglary with the help of his associates.

### Man found dead in his house

A 34-year-old man was found dead next to a charred mattress inside his house in Saligramam on Monday. According to K K Nagar police, the deceased, T Netaji, was employed in a private software company and lived alone in a rented house. Around 3 am on Monday, neighbours noticed smoke coming out of his house and found him lying unconscious near his bed. "We suspect a cigarette spark behind the fire. Netaji should have been in deep sleep and died of suffocation," police said

### Construction workers falls dies

A 45-year-old worker was killed at a construction site in Saligramam on Saturday. The police have filed a case. A senior police official said Srinivasan had been working at the site for the past 15 days. On Saturday afternoon, while he was constructing a temporary shed on the first floor of the building, he lost his footing and fell from a height of 22 feet. He suffered a severe head injury, and was rushed to a hospital, where doctors declared him brought dead.

## CM Stalin launches QR code-based emergency system for passenger safety

hief Minister M K Stalin launched a QR codebased emergency response system in Chennai to enhance passenger safety, especially for women and



children, in auto rickshaws, cabs, and car rentals. The Greater Chennai Police has generated 88,859 unique QR codes for autos and share autos, which will be placed behind the driver's seat for easy scanning.

By scanning the QR code and pressing the SOS button, passengers can instantly alert the police control room with real-time location, driver details, and vehicle information. The system ensures swift police response, especially during night travel or solo rides. The police have also integrated Rapido, Ola, and Uber's emergency alerts with their control room for immediate action.

The launch event at the Secretariat was attended by Ministers K Ponmudy and PK Sekarbabu, Chief Secretary N Muruganandam, and Chennai Police Commissioner A Arun.



# Post Office to open savings accounts through 'e-KYC'

The facility to open savings accounts through the 'e-KYC' system has been made available at post offices," said G. Natarajan, Head of the Chennai Urban Zone Postal Department. In this regard, he said: Savings accounts, including savings accounts and recurring deposit accounts (Rds), are being implemented at post offices. Those who wish to open these accounts must submit documents including their address certificate and Aadhaar number. In this situation, in order to reduce the use of paper, the facility to open savings accounts through the 'e-KYC' method has been introduced at post offices. Accordingly, customers can easily open a savings account through fingerprint (biometric) registration using their Aadhaar number. For this, the General Post Office (GPO) at Parimunai, which falls under the Chennai City Postal Circle, Anna Salai, Park Town, T. Nagar, Mylapore.

# Cameras for safety

Residents appeal for removal of old transformer

Disposal of obsolete and failed transformers and other electrical equipment such as regulators, capacitors and breakers can be unsafe and a liability.

TANGEDCO must remove the transformer as early as possible as it is an impediment to the pedestrian pathway on Valliamal Garden, Rangarajapuram.

Utilities use massive step-up transformers to increase voltage in order to push electricity more efficiently through long-distance transmission lines. Problem is, each will eventually wear out and require hazardous waste disposal. In a typical large transformer, 50% of the cost is in materials.

Of that, about 15% to 20% is for copper and an equal percentage is for steel structural members and core laminations with the remainder in oil, insulation and the rest, says Gajendran, a retired electrical engineer.

The residents appeal for an early action by TANGEDCO before it gets stolen from the footpath.
